



Triunfo Announces its Operational Data – 9M14

São Paulo, October 13, 2014 - Triunfo Participações e Investimentos S.A. (TPIS3), one of the Brazilian companies with the strongest presence in the infrastructure sector, announces its operational data.

Highways Segment

In the first nine months of 2014, our highway concessions registered traffic of 64.9 million vehicle-equivalents, which represents an increase of 2.6% from the same period of 2013. The individual performance in the same period of our concessionaries Concer, Concepa and Econorte was traffic growth of 0.6%, 6.9% and -0.8%, respectively.

Note that Concer's negative performance reflects the installation of the highway project Arco Metropolitano do Rio de Janeiro. The loss in traffic at Concer due to the project's inauguration was already expected. To maintain the equilibrium of the concession contract, the last amendment signed in August incorporated the effects of this loss into the toll, with the tariff increased by 12.5%, which corresponds to inflation + 5.29%. A second portion of the increase will be applied in the 2015 tariff revision to offset the entire traffic loss caused by the change in the city's highway infrastructure.

Port Segment

In the first nine months of 2014, container handling grew 0.6% from the same period in 2013 to reach 524,629 TEUs. In September, Portonave reversed the negative performance observed in the year to August. During the month, the terminal handled 65,069 TEUs, or 22.5% more than in September 2013.

Power Generation Segment

The physical guarantee sold by Rio Verde to Votener amounted to 444,293 MWh in the first nine months of 2014 and 48,816 MWh in September. At Rio Canoas, the physical guarantee sold amounted to 329,336 MWh in the year to date and 28,047 MWh in September.

This year there was a reduction of 6,58% in the physical guarantee at plants, until August.
